GENTLE REMINDERS

- Have your line up in written/electronic form prior to arrival.
- Post scores within 48 hours
- Please make every effort to play lines early when availability is an issue- Invalid matches could remove your team from the schedule.
- Inclement weather-Arrangements must be made within 36 hours from original match date



CHANGES TO RULES/REGULATIONS

- All evening matches must complete a third set tiebreaker in lieu of a third set. Evening matches are deemed any match that starts at 6pm or later.
- 40 plus will be 1 line of singles and 4 lines of doubles
- 18 and over men's will continue to be 2 lines of singles and 3 lines of doubles
- 18 and over women's will be 1 line of singles and 4 lines of doubles



- 8. The other captain and I can't agree on the order of play when we only have 3 courts, What is the procedure?
- 9. What happens if it rains on the makeup match day?-What happens if it rains on the default day?
- 10. What happens if the weather is below 32 or above 95 at match time?
- 11. How do I file a grievance? Is there a time limit?

REMINDER ABOUT RESCHEDULING

- Arrangements must be made within 36 hours from original match date
- ALL Matches rescheduled due to inclement weather must be emailed to the LLC and opposing Captain with the <u>Original Match Date</u> and <u>NEW Dates</u>, <u>Times</u>, and <u>LOCATION</u> for <u>each</u> line.
- Once teams agree on a rescheduled date and time, the make-up match may not be canceled by either party except for inclement weather. But substitutions can be made.
